APPLICANT CERTIFICATION

I certify that I am familiar with and will comply with La. R.S. 51:650 et seq., and NFPA standards 1123 (Code for Fireworks Display), 1124 (Code for the Manufacture, Transportation, and Storage of Fireworks and Pyrotechnic Articles), Class C Public Display excepted, and 1126 (Standard for the Use of Pyrotechnics Before a Proximate Audience), Class C Public Display excepted. Furthermore, I will comply with La. R.S. 32:1501–1520 and all regulations adopted and enforced by the Louisiana State Police. Additionally, I understand that if displays conducted at locations subject to multiple jurisdictions, I must submit and receive approval, where required, before the date of the display by each applicable jurisdiction. Multiple jurisdictions include, but are not limited to the following:

- · Public display in harbors or on a navigable waterway should be approved by the U.S. Coast Guard or other maritime authority.
- Public displays on river or water shed levees should be approved by the appropriate Louisiana levee district and/or Parish Water Shed District.
- Public display in the vicinity of a commercial airport or heliport should be approved by the Federal Aviation Administration or other aviation authority.
- A Notice to Airmen (NOTAM) should be issued to alert aircraft operators of the location and time of the public display to avoid conflicts with air operations.
- Public displays that require permission to close roadways, divert traffic, or restrict access to roadways or other public rights of way should be obtained from the
 appropriate authorities.
