Identify rigging techniques to assist in the rescue of victims or stabilization of collapsed buildings

Coordinate efforts between Task Force personnel and heavy equipment operators

Assist the Task Force in procuring heavy equipment

Provide accountability, maintenance, and repairs for all issued equipment
