FLYER FOR THE LA OSFM INSTRUCTOR II COURSE

The Louisiana State Fire Marshal's Office will conduct an Instructor II course at any location designated by a requesting agency. The course will be conducted as follows:

- Length: 2 days
- Time: approximately 8 hours per day
- Main topics
 - Characteristics of a good instructor
 - Classroom preparation
 - Lesson plan preparation
 - Training plan preparation
 - Individual class
 - Annual
 - Use of audiovisual equipment
 - Budgeting
 - o Equipment
 - Procurement
 - Maintenance
 - Student testing

Students will become competent through classroom training, practical application and conducting their own class. Students must participate in all practical exercises. Students will need to bring a laptop computer with internet access to the class. The OSFM will provide a lead instructor/class validator. Students will receive a certificate from the Fire Marshal's Office and the requesting agency will receive the following documentation:
