FLYER FOR THE LA OSFM PLANS MANAGER COURSE
The Louisiana State Fire Marshal's Office will conduct a US & R
Plans Manager course at any location designated by a
requesting agency.

The course will be conducted as follows:

- Length: 4 days
- Time: approximately 8 hours per day
- Main topics
 - o General planning techniques
 - o The Planning P
 - o Pre-incident planning
 - O Using a map and GPS
 - o Activation procedures
 - Point of Departure and Point of Arrival procedures
 - o Planning team functions
 - o **Documentation**
 - o Situation Reports
 - o **Demobilization**
 - o After Action Review

Students will become competent through classroom training, practical application and the performance of scenario exercises. Students must successfully complete practical performances complete all practical exercises as well as the final exercise to graduate this course. The OSFM will provide a lead instructor and a thumb drive containing a vast amount of informational data that will help students in future operations. This course is conducted entirely in the classroom so no PPE is required. Students may wish to bring a computer to study the data given in the thumb drive, however this is not a necessity for the course. Students will receive a certificate from the Fire Marshal's Office and the requesting agency will receive the following documentation:

- Roster
- Lesson plan
- Training plan
- Power point hand out
- Individual student practical application scoresheets
