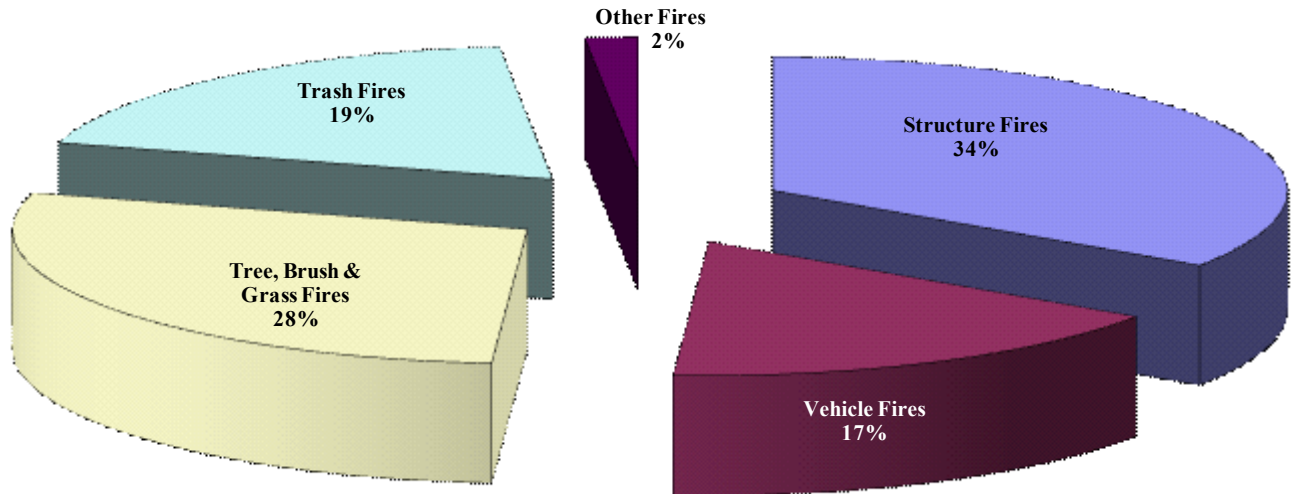

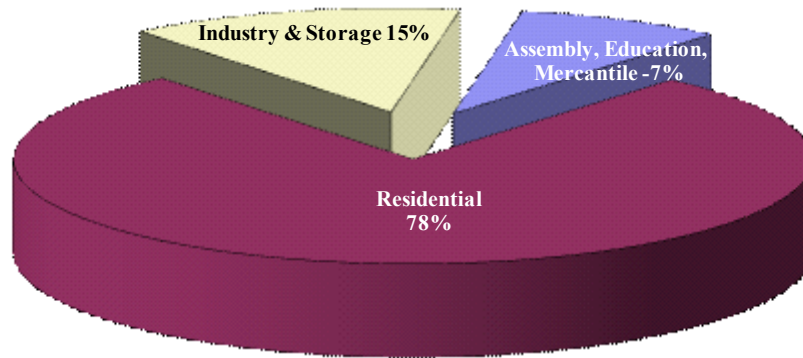

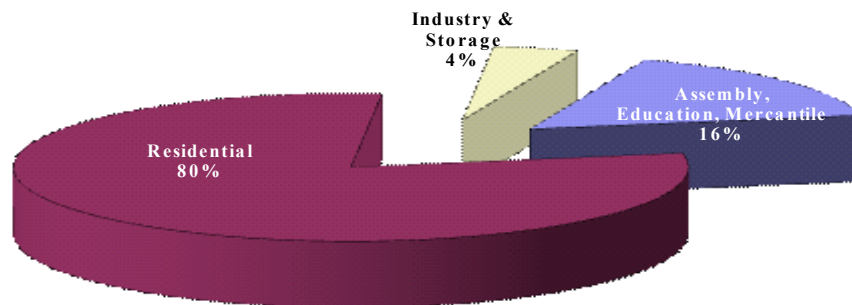
Fires by Type

Fire Dollar Loss by Property Type

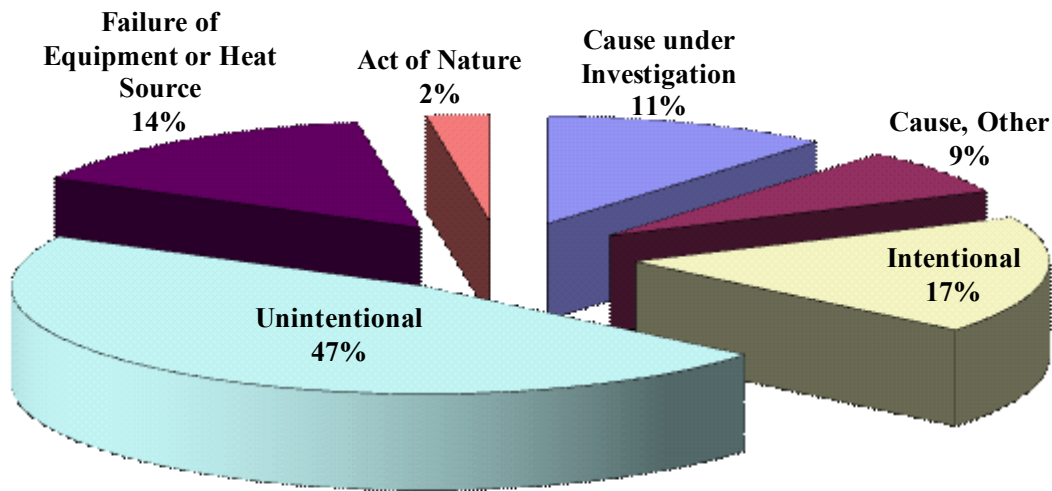

Cause of Ignition



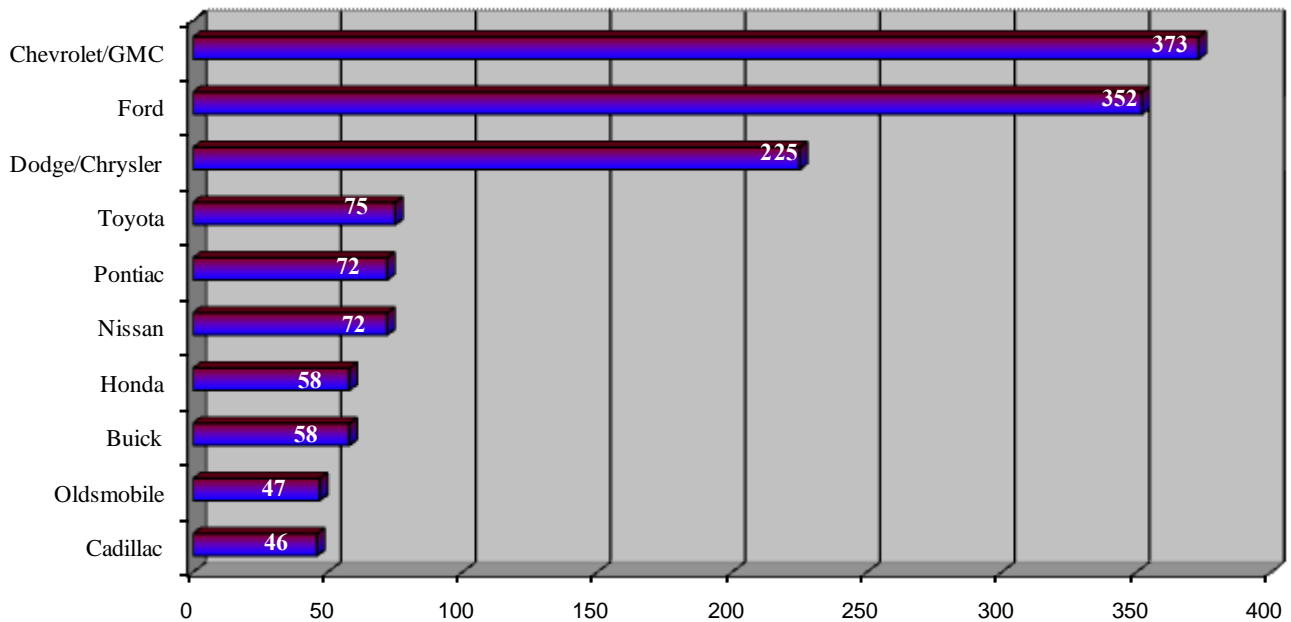

Fires by Automobile Make 2008



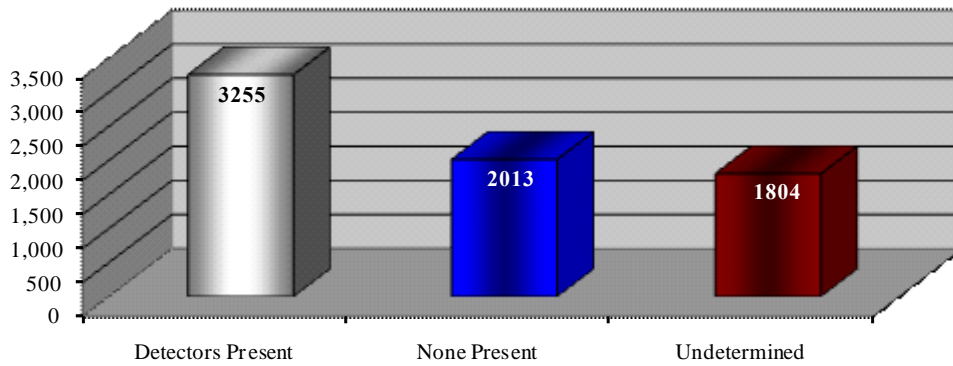

Area of Fire Origin in Residential Properties



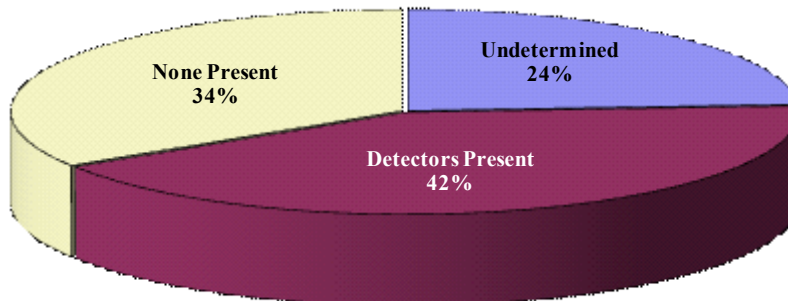

Smoke Detector Presence

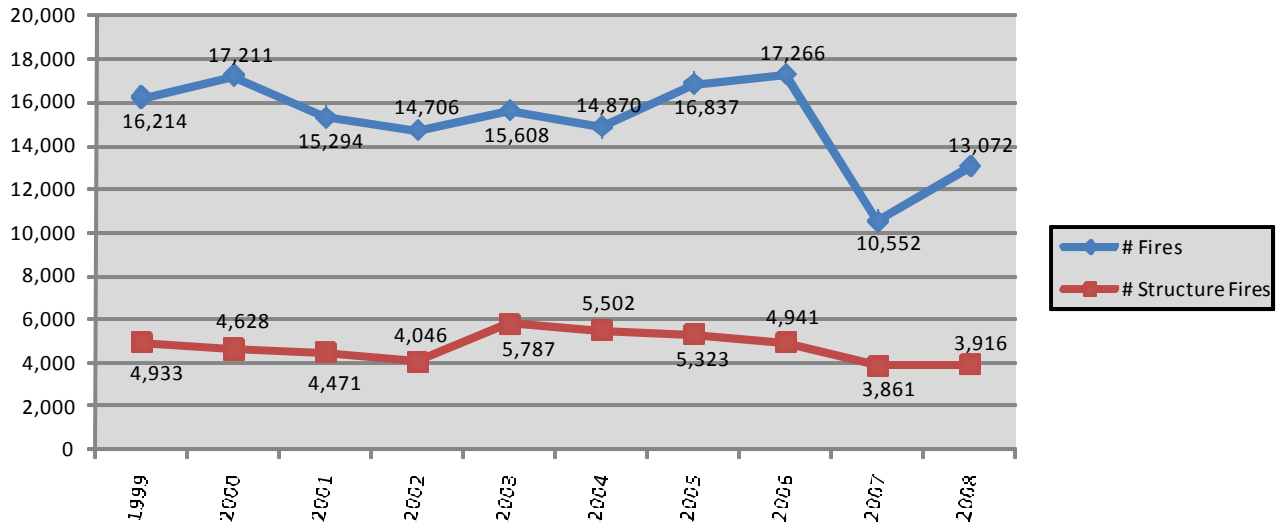


Residential fires account for 78% of all structure fires and continue to be the most common and deadly type of fire, demonstrating the need and importance of home fire prevention and safety practices.

Percent of Deaths & Injuries based on Smoke Detector Presence

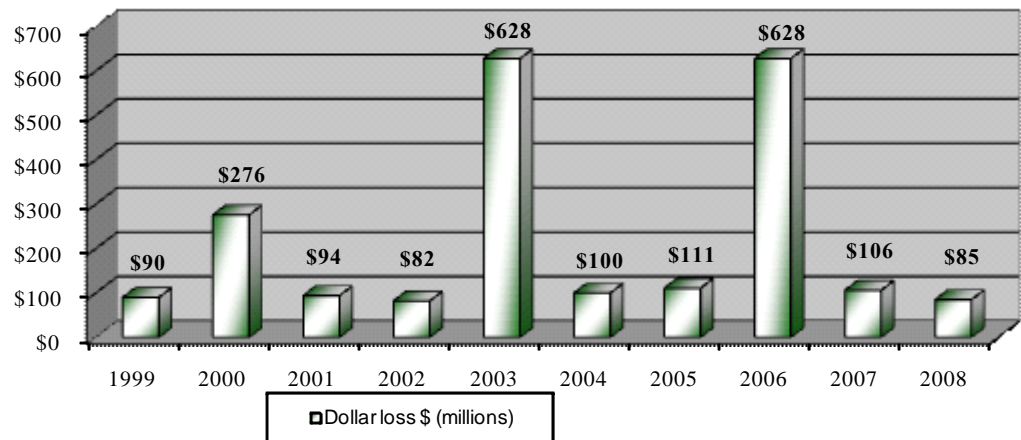


Louisiana Fire Statistics 1999-2008

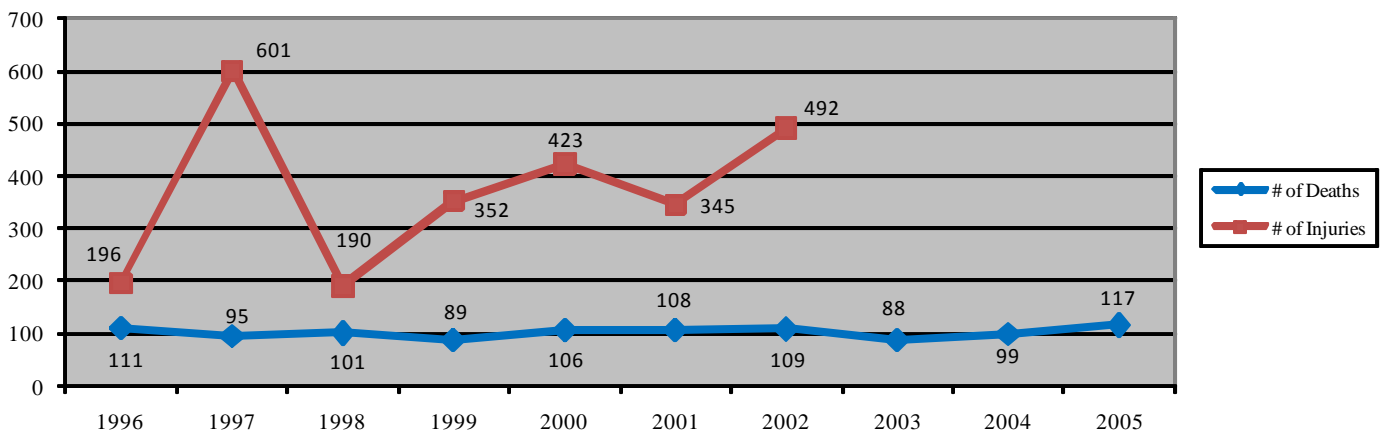


Total Fire Dollar Loss

Louisiana Fire Incident Reporting System (LFIRS)

This section of the State Fire Marshal's office collects and maintains data submitted from fire departments and compiles statistics on fires in an effort to determine the impact of fire on the lives of our citizens and property in Louisiana. LFIRS (NFIRS) is the program through which this data is collected.

LFIRS (NFIRS) is ***all incident reporting***. To show and tell the full value of the fire service, all alarms or public service calls should be documented in LFIRS. Many departments only report their fire calls. However, national statistics show that only about 20% of all calls to which a fire department responds are fire-related. For this reason, we would like you to report all calls to which your department responds. We want your department to be recognized for all that it does! By collecting data on both fire and non-fire response efforts of our fire departments, we can identify personnel, equipment and training needs of our fire service and document the full impact our fire service has in our communities. Plus, grant programs available to fire departments are requiring that the department be participating in NFIRS (LFIRS) to be eligible. Participation in incident reporting also provides your department with opportunity to gain bonus points applied toward your PIAL rating.

We commend and encourage the continuing effort from fire departments to move from paper to electronic reporting. With the changing role of the fire department there is now more than ever, the need for the use of computers in our fire stations. Electronic reporting provides us with a more efficient means to respond to your report submissions, to notify you of any errors, and offer more ready assistance in completing your reports. In addition, email submission reduces paper and postage costs.

Inspections Section

The Inspections Section (Fire and Safety) is responsible for conducting life safety code inspections of all buildings except one and two family residences and Health Care facilities.



Total Inspections 2006-2008



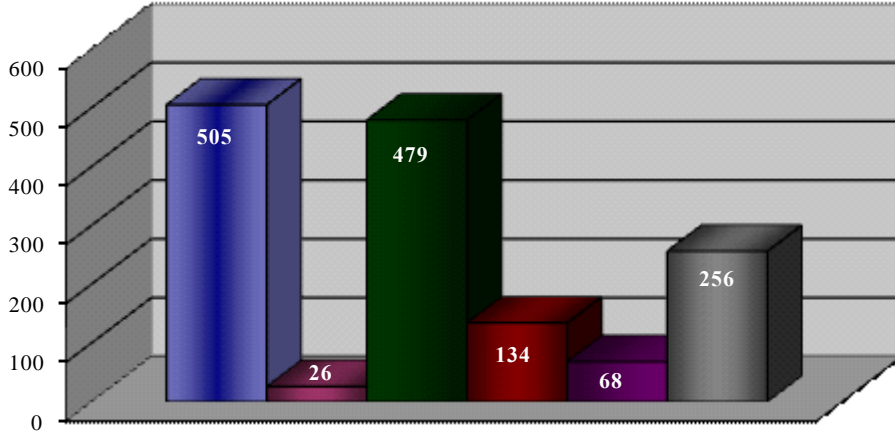
Effective July 1, 2004, inspections of new construction are conducted utilizing the 2003 edition of NFPA 101 Life Safety Code and referenced NFPA standards. Additionally, other codes and standards used are the Southern Standard Building Code for high-rise buildings, Americans with Disabilities Act Accessibility Guidelines (ADAAG) and the State Fire Marshal Act. Inspections of existing buildings are conducted utilizing the edition of the Life Safety Code that was adopted by the state at the time that the building was constructed. For example, if a building was constructed in 1970, the inspection would be conducted in accordance with the requirements as set forth in the 1967 Life Safety Code.

In order to provide efficient service to the public and allow facilities to open in a timely manner, the State Fire Marshal's office maintained its goal of completing final inspections within two weeks it being requested. The first diagram above indicates the percentage of final inspections conducted in accordance with this goal. The second diagram indicates the total number of inspections for specific occupancy types.

In order to ensure that inspections are conducted in accordance with the adopted codes, rules, laws and regulations, District Supervisors and Assistant Supervisors conducted 6,536 field Quality Control inspections during 2006. The Quality Control Program includes conducting training inspections and revisiting facilities to ensure that the inspectors are citing codes properly and consistently. Supervisors and Managers use this information to evaluate and provide of the training needs for the inspection staff.

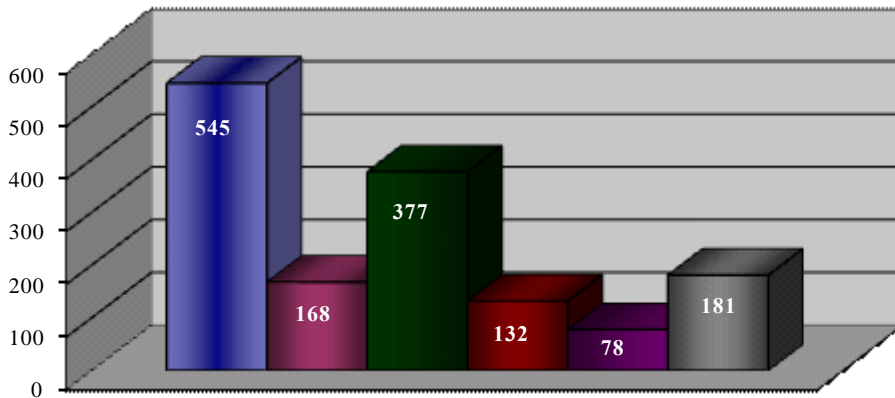

Arson Statistics - Calendar Year 2006



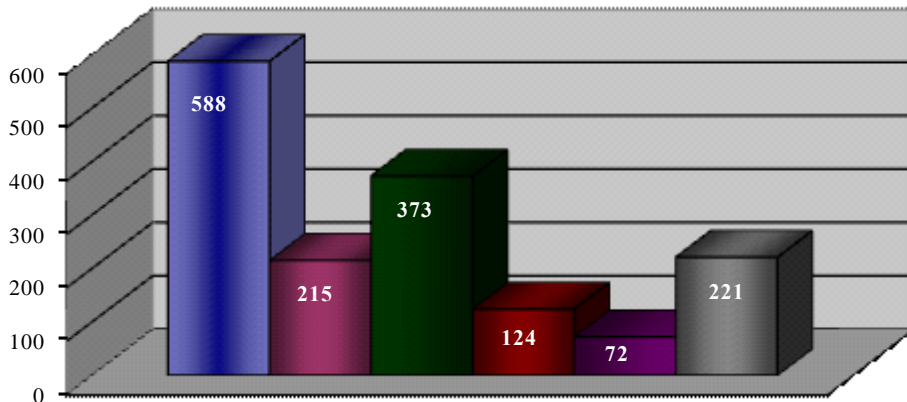

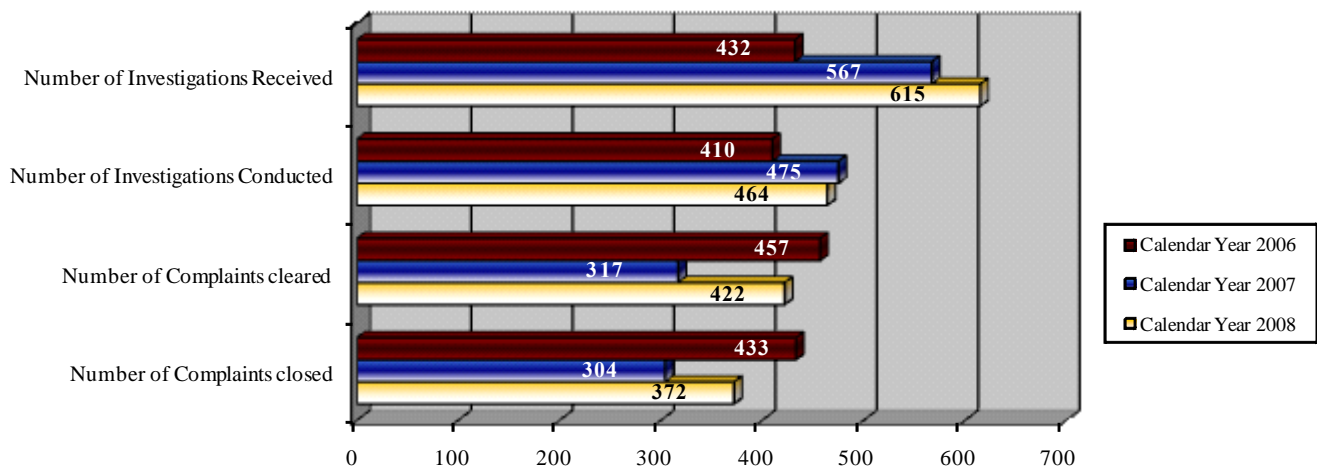

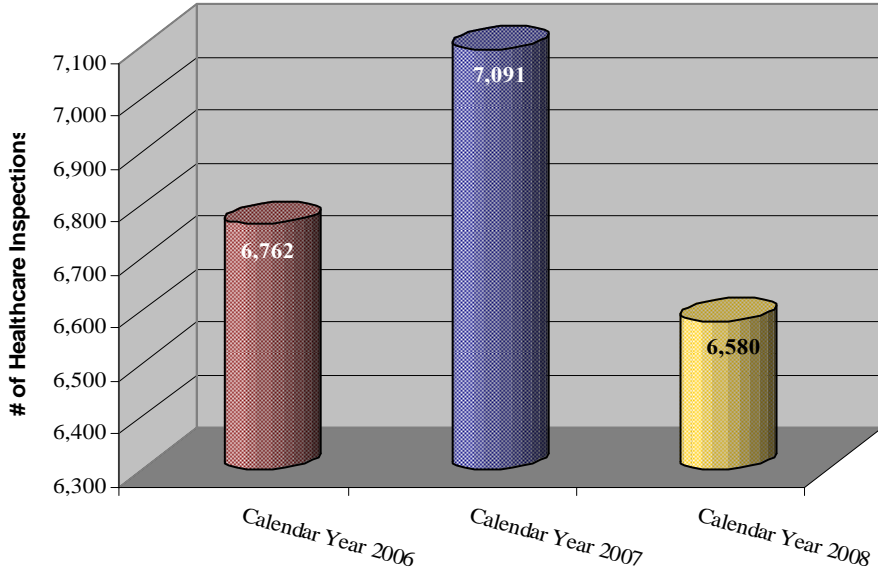

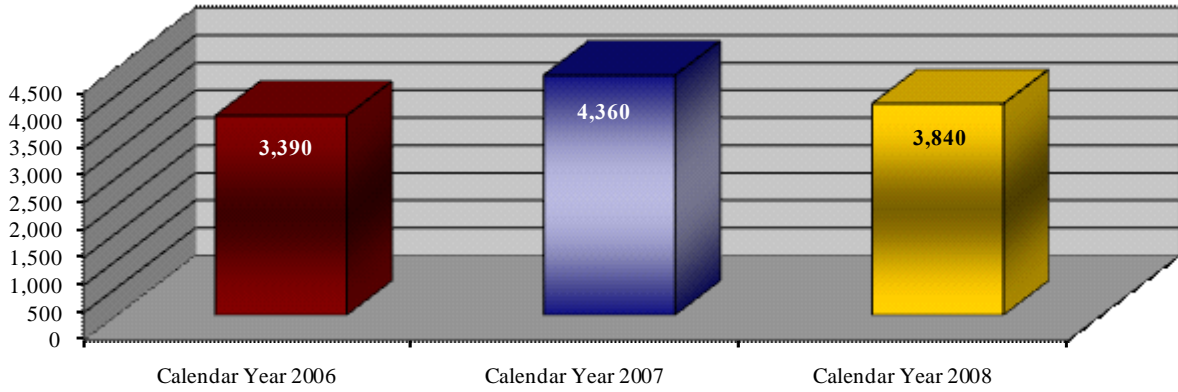
Healthcare Hour Percentage - 2008



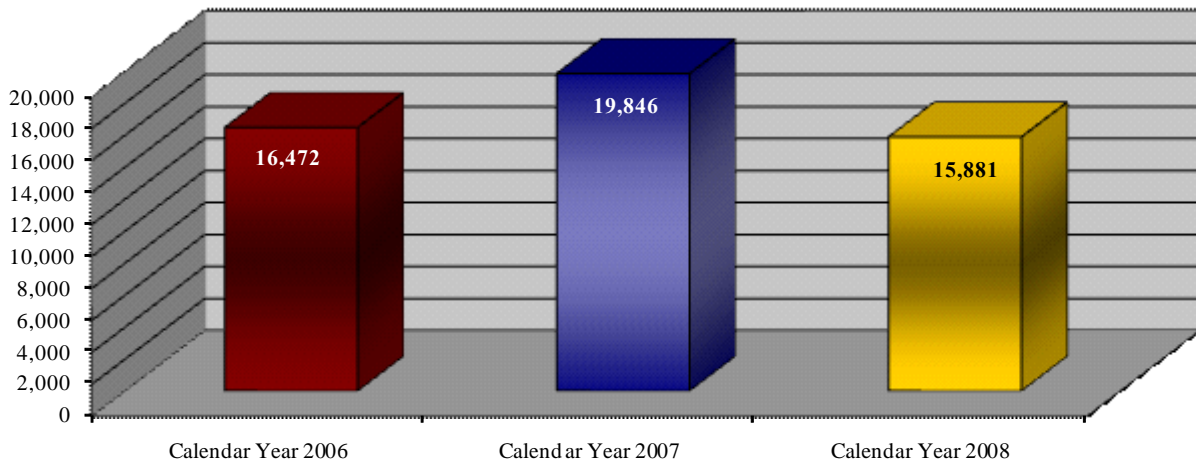

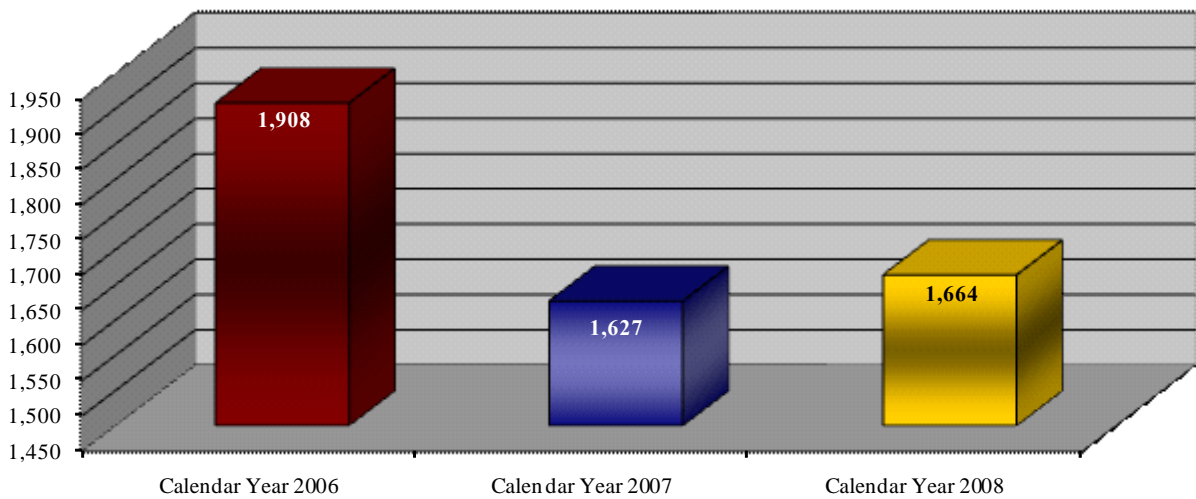

Fire Education

The State Fire Marshal has three "Hazard Houses" to be used as educational tools targeting elementary aged children. The house is an interactive 3-D tool that allows the instructor and children to interact and recognize and correct items and activity in the home. The house illustrates unsafe behaviors and can simulate smoke and electrical shorts, which is useful in maintaining children's attention as well as reinforcing the safety message. Emergency Services

The Fire Marshal's office has consolidated its broad spectrum of emergency service activities into one cooperative effort to improve and enhance disaster preparedness initiatives, emergency response operations and long term disaster planning and recovery. This program directly and indirectly affects the estimated 4,523,628 citizens of the state of Louisiana that are exposed to natural disasters or acts of terrorism. This program encompasses the following services:

- **Regional ERT (Emergency Response Team)** – A 40-man team trained in command, communications, and medical, and rescue, created to support local fire departments and state agencies in times of crisis, both natural and man-made.
- **Asset/Resource Inventory** – As a function of Emergency Support Function (ESF)-4, we are tasked to coordinate and mobilize fire and emergency services resources, personnel and equipment; and coordinate other state resources to support local governments and other states to detect and suppress urban, rural, wild land emergencies. Our objective is to lead a collaborative effort within the Fire Service to assist and facilitate the acquisition, data storage and management of Resources and Assets that may be available in the event of a disaster or major catastrophe.
- **ESF-4 Disaster Preparedness Training Program** – State Fire Marshal initiative to educate fire departments and first responders to better prepare them in the event of natural or man-made disasters.

1. **To All Volunteer Firefighters** - Group medical benefits available to you through the State Fire Marshal's Volunteer Firemen's Insurance Program through Harford Insurance.
2. **To All Volunteer Firefighters** – Effective November 1, 2009, Worker's Compensation Insurance Coverage for Louisiana's Active Volunteer Firefighters with LWCC.
3. **Scholarship for children of firefighters killed or disabled in performance of duty** - Paid and volunteer for fees, tuition or other charity including room and board as long as child meets the academic requirements and maintains a "C" average. In addition such children shall be entitled to a cash grant of \$240 per semester as an allowance for books etc. (LA RS.17:1682)
4. **\$50,000 accidental death** resulting in course of performance of official duties payment by State Risk Manager out to the self insurance fund credited in (LA RS.39:1533).
5. **Public Safety Officers and Firefighter death benefits** - Act USC 3796 et. seq. was enacted in 1976, as of 10/1/00 PSOB's benefit increased to \$267,494.00.
6. **Louisiana State Firemen's Association** - \$15,000 accidental death benefit for fatality in the line of duty
