RE: 988 Dialing Changes

As you know, the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) has mandated a change in the manner in which people who may be in need of suicide prevention counseling to phone the National Suicide Prevention Lifeline by dialing 988 instead of 1-800-273-TALK (8255), which is the current method of calling. This change is scheduled to take effect on July 16, 2022.

While we are in full support of the need to simplify calling a helpful resource for those in need, this change, which has affected over thirty-six (36) states, requires that in order to phone customers who have a 988 prefix the area code must be included when calling. In Louisiana, this has unfortunately impacted thousands of life safety and property protection systems in private and commercial structures in the 337 and 504 area codes, respectively.

Factors, such as a lack of timely notification of the impending changes, COVID-19, unavailability of needed system parts for reprogramming and/or replacement, and the devastating effects of hurricanes in 2020 and 2021, have resulted in an insufficient time during which the reprogramming of these vital systems can be accomplished.

State Fire Marshal Browning has been in consultation regarding this matter with the major carriers in Louisiana, AT&T and Cox Communications, both of which have expressed a desire to assist in requesting a delay from the FFC in the implementation of the calling changes mentioned above, specifically, to delay the implementation by three (3) months—to October 2022—in order to provide more time for our industry partners to complete the reprogramming of all life safety and property protection systems in the 337 and 504 area codes.
