State Fire Marshal Charges Vidalia Man in Intentional Vehicle Fire Investigation

CONCORDIA PARISH (June 30, 2026) – The Louisiana Office of State Fire Marshal (SFM) has charged a Vidalia man following an investigation that determined a vehicle fire in Concordia Parish was intentionally set.

SFM deputies charged 48-year-old Keon Moore of Vidalia with Automobile Insurance Fraud, Criminal Mischief and Obstruction of Justice.

Concordia Parish Fire District 2 responded to a vehicle fire at 10:16 p.m. March 30, 2026, on Levee Heights Road near Fisherman Drive in Ferriday. The State Fire Marshal's Investigations Unit responded at the request of the Concordia Parish Sheriff's Office.

Following an investigation, SFM deputies determined the fire had been intentionally set. Evidence collected during the investigation confirmed the involvement of the vehicle's owner.

As a result of the investigation, arrest warrants were obtained for Moore. He surrendered to the Concordia Parish Sheriff's Office on June 30, 2026.

The SFM would like to thank the Concordia Parish Sheriff's Office and Concordia Parish Fire District 2 for their assistance in this case.

This remains an active investigation, and no further details are being released at this time.
