## Tangipahoa Parish Woman Arrested for Aggravated Arson Following Fire

**TANGIPAHOA PARISH (December 3, 2025)** – The Louisiana Office of State Fire Marshal (SFM) has arrested a Loranger woman in connection with a deliberately set fire at an occupied mobile home.

At approximately 7:19 a.m. on December 3, 2025, the Husser Fire Department was dispatched to a residence in the 24000 block of Gliderport Road in Loranger. Both individuals inside the mobile home were able to escape safely and were not injured.

SFM investigators called to the scene determined the blaze had been intentionally ignited. Their investigation led to 45-year-old April Delaney, who has since been charged with a single count of Aggravated Arson. Investigators have not yet confirmed whether the home was equipped with a functional smoke alarm.

Chief Bryan J. Adams, DPS Principal Assistant, reminds residents across Louisiana of the importance of having working smoke alarms in every home. Through Operation Save-A-Life, the SFM offers free smoke alarms and installation for Louisiana residents.

The SFM expresses its gratitude to the Husser Fire Department for its swift response and valuable collaboration throughout the investigation.
