State Fire Marshal Investigates Intentionally Set Fire at Church

OUACHITA PARISH - The State Fire Marshal's Office and the Monroe Fire Department are jointly investigating an intentionally set fire at a Monroe church. The fire was quickly extinguished by firefighters but not before destroying the building.

The Monroe Fire Department responded shortly before 2 p.m. Sunday, March 30, 2025, to a reported fire at the St. Mary's Number 2 Missionary Baptist Church located at 100 Williams Street. Firefighters arrived and found heavy smoke and the church on fire. Fire crews quickly extinguished the blaze within minutes.

Surveillance video shows a person intentionally setting the church on fire. We are hoping the public can help us identify and locate the person/persons responsible.
