## Louisiana Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Public Safety Services Public Notice of Title VI Program Rights

The Louisiana Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Public Safety Services (LA DPS PSS) gives notice that it is the policy of all LA DPS PSS Offices to assure compliance with the following Federal acts and regulations:

- Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, which prohibits discrimination based on race, color, or national origin (including limited English proficiency).
- Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, which prohibits discrimination based on disability.
- Title IX of the Education Amendments Act of 1972, which prohibits discrimination based on sex in education programs or activities.
- Age Discrimination Act of 1975, which prohibits discrimination based on age.
- U.S. Department of Homeland Security regulation 6 C.F.R. Part 19, which prohibits discrimination based on religion in social service programs.

Anyone who believes they have experienced discrimination based on race, color, national origin, sex, age, disability, income level, or Limited English Proficiency has the right to file a formal complaint. Complaints must be submitted using the <u>*Title VI and Related Authorities Complaint Form*</u> within 180 days of the alleged discriminatory incident.
