New Orleans Man Arrested in Connection with Arson, Domestic Disturbance Incident

ORLEANS PARISH (March 17, 2026) – On Monday, March 16, 2026, State Fire Marshal (SFM) investigators charged 35-year-old Quinton Rene Quinn of New Orleans with Aggravated Arson in connection with a fire and domestic disturbance situation that occurred in October 2025.

Around 1:30 a.m. on October 19, 2025, the New Orleans Police Department (NOPD) responded to a domestic disturbance at an apartment in the 7700 block of Downman Road in New Orleans. Quinn placed a towel in the oven and turned it on. NOPD contacted the Office of State Fire Marshal to investigate the fire.

Following an investigation, SFM investigators determined Quinn intentionally set the fire. Additional investigative work revealed the incident was connected to a domestic disturbance situation between Quinn and a woman.

On Saturday, March 14, 2026, the Orleans Parish Sheriff's Office arrested Quinn on a fugitive warrant, unrelated to the SFM investigation. On Monday, SFM Deputies charged Quinn with one count of Aggravated Arson.
