OF ONEHOUR F.R. JEPORSTION. I am in receipt of your letter dated July 14, 1983, in which 🧲 you are requesting clarification of the code requirements concerning separation between guest rooms. 11-6-96

All dwelling units or apartments within LAC 4.4. multiple dwellings shall be separated from one another by construction having a fire resistance rating of not less than one hour as required by the Standard Building Code.

This requirement applies only to dwelling units and apartments, it does not apply to hotel and motel guest rooms. Therefore, Item Number 4 on Mr. Clinton R. Dobson's review letter dated July 6, 1983, shall not be required or enforced.
